Individual Reservations: Individual families may also sign up for Fall Festival if the Pack date(s) doesn't fit the family's schedule. Please make sure to **know your Pack number**, it will be needed at check-in.

What to Bring: Each Cub Scout and adult must have proper outdoor clothing and sturdy footwear. Programs are on rain or shine. Each Cub Scout, sibling and adult must bring with them a Health History form with signed parent authorization to participate in BB guns and receive medical care.

Council's Weather Policy: Decisions for official camp closing will be made by the Camping Director. When camps are officially closed fees may be transferred to another date, or refunded. More often than not, we will not close the camps. Each Pack will be contacted if a program were to be cancelled.

GENERAL INFORMATION & POLICIES FOR ALL LOCATIONS

Reservations: Will open on August 24, 2009 at 8:00am. Half down is required at time of reservation. All fees are due by September 21, 2009. After September 21, full payment will be required at the time of reservation. Make your reservations at www.goscouting.org or by filling out the reservation form. **No reservations will be accepted over the phone.**

Cancellation Policy: All fees are non-refundable. (Special circumstances may be requested in writing) If payment is not received by the total fee due date, reservations will be reduced or cancelled based on payments received to date. Reservations made after the total fee due date requires full payment at time of reservation.

Adult Leadership: One adult per 8 Cub/Webelos Scout with a minimum of 2 adults per group participating. Tiger Cubs must have an adult partner.
