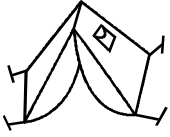


# CAMP GREENWOOD Heritage Cub Outpost

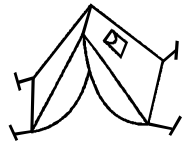
Here are some important things to know about Cub Outpost, that will help you prepare for your trip:

- All participants will be sleeping in tents on the ground-camp will provide sleeping mats-but bring your own if you think you'll need more cushion
- Dinner on Sunday & breakfast on Monday are cooked in the campsite, Outpost will conclude before lunch on Monday

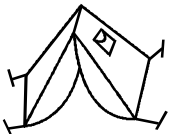
