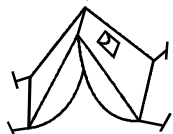


# CAMP NAVAJO WEBELOS OUTPOST

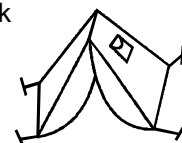
Here are some important things to know about Webelos Outpost, that will help you prepare for your trip:

- Outpost starts at 1:00 on Saturday/Tuesdays-after the Navajo session has ended
- Outpost participants will check-in all participants at the dining hall
  - Participating youth & adults will need to bring their health forms with them to outpost-Navajo staff does not hold onto them after check-out
- All participants will be hiking to the campsite, and carrying all their outpost items with them. A daypack backpack and stuffable sleeping bag is a must for outpost
- All participants will be sleeping in tents on the ground. Camp will provide sleeping mats-but bring your own if you think you'll need more cushion
- Dinner on Saturday/Tuesday & breakfast on Sunday/Wednesday are cooked in the campsite, Outpost will conclude after lunch on Sunday/Wednesday

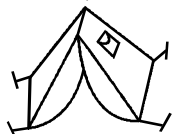
