# 2012 Polar Cubs



- WHEN:** Weekends beginning January 7 and ending March 4.  
Registration is at 8:15 a.m. Opening Ceremony starts promptly at 9:00 a.m., with the day ending at 3:30 p.m.
- LOCATION:** Choose from Phillippo Scout Reservation, Rum River Scout Camp or Stearns Scout Camp
- RESERVATIONS:** Open October 3, 2011. Visit [www.goscouting.org](http://www.goscouting.org) to check availability. Space availability can be viewed without a login, any registered adult can obtain a login to make a pack or den reservation. Mail or in-person reservations will be accepted by using the official registration form with unit deposit enclosed. Total fees will be due by November 21, 2011. **Phone reservations and facsimile reservations will not be accepted.**
- PAYMENT & CANCELATION POLICY:** All fees are non-refundable. Deposits paid prior to the total fee due date are applied to any remaining 2012 Polar Cub session balance. If payment is not received by the total fee due date, reservations will be reduced or cancelled based on payments received to date. Reservations made after the total fee due date require payment on-line or within 10 days of invoicing, if payment is not received reservation will be reduced or cancelled.
- INDIVIDUAL RESERVATIONS:** Individual families may also sign up for Polar Cubs if the Pack date(s) doesn't fit the family's schedule. Space Availability is shown at [www.goscouting.org](http://www.goscouting.org). (All youth must be registered with the Boy Scouts—**no siblings at Polar Cubs**)
- ADULT LEADERSHIP:** One adult per 8 Cub/Webelos Scouts with a minimum of 2 adults per group participating. Lion and Tiger Cubs need to attend with an adult partner. (1/1 ratio of youth to adult) (All youth must be registered with the Boy Scouts—**no siblings at Polar Cubs**)
- WHAT TO BRING:** Each Cub Scout and adult must have proper winter outdoor clothing including: snow suits/pants, boots, hats and 2 pair of mittens, health form with signed parent authorization to participate and to receive medical care. - COUNCIL'S WEATHER POLICY:** Decisions for official camp closing will be made by the Camping Director. When camps are officially closed, fees will either be transferred to another weekend within the Polar Cubs season. More often than not, we will not close the camps.
