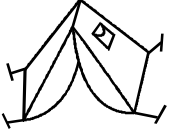


CAMP NAVAJO WEBELOS OUTPOST

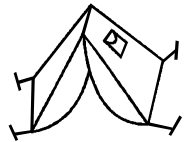
Here are some important things to know about Webelos Outpost, that will help you prepare for your trip:

- Outpost starts at 1:00 on Saturday/Tuesdays-after Navajo has ended
- Outpost will have check-in for all participants in the dining hall
 - Participating youth & adults will need to bring their health forms with them to out post- Navajo staff does not hold onto them after check-out on Mondays
- All participants will be hiking to the campsite, and carrying all their outpost items with them-a daypack backpack and stuffable sleeping bag is a must for outpost
- All participants will be sleeping in tents on the ground-camp will provide sleeping mats-but bring your own if you think you'll need more cushion
- Dinner on Saturday/Tuesday & breakfast on Sunday/Wednesday are cooked in the campsite, Outpost will conclude before lunch on Sunday/Wednesday
