RE: 2009 Cub & Webelos Summer Camp Packets



The packet that you have received in the mail today is very important in planning your group's trip to Cub Scout or Webelos Scout Camp this summer. Please take note of the following items:

- **There are forms in this packet that you are responsible for sharing with the other adults in your group.** These include: health history forms (one for every participant), leader information sheets (one for every adult registered), and a Webelos Outpost sheet if you have Scouts signed up for a Webelos Outpost.
- Each Resident Camp (excluding Webelos Adventure Days) has a 'Leader's Manual' please read through it carefully to make sure that your group will be prepared for camp.
- If you have made reservations for more than one camp program, information for each camp is included in this packet, so there will be some material that is specific to certain programs.
- We can accommodate many special requests, including diet needs, but we need to know about them ahead of time. For directions that are specific to the camp you will be attending, please read the '**Handling Special Requests**' sheeting included with your information
- Both youth and adults need to take a swim test before they can participate in any aquatics activities at camp. The best time to take this test is **before** you get to camp with your Pack at a local pool because doing this at camp takes valuable program time you could spend doing something really fun. The leader's guide explains how you do this. Packs that do not do the test ahead of time need to be prepared to do it first thing when they arrive at camp.
- **Every participant (youth and adult)** will be required to turn in a health history form upon arrival at camp. There should be enough copies of the form in this packet for everyone. Please make sure that you bring these forms, filled out properly to your camp session.
